BABCOCK, Stephen Moulton, 1843-1931. Conn. born. Educated at home and abroad. Inventor of the Babcock Test for butterfat content of milk. Its financial benefits to farmers have been continuous and tremendous. But this was not all he did. Dr. Glenn Frank, Pres. Univ. Wis., after Dr, Babcock's death at 88, closed a characterization of him thus:

"Scholar of a great university
Servant of a great state
Shy benefactor of mankind everywhere
Laughing saint of science
Being dead he yet speaks."
