 : estry 2 years in Europe. Univ. Munich, D.Ec., 1910.
 CUT : Keen student of land use. Mainly devoted to degree
 : course ed. at 3 land-grant colleges and as Dean of
 : N.Y.St. Col. Forestry at Syracuse; but has aided non-
 degree course training. While organizing Forestry
 Dept. at Iowa St. Col., 1904-1905, gave a Forestry short course at
 Colorado St. Col., probably the first in the United States. Also he org
 organized the N.Y.St. Ranger Sch. at Wanakena, first of its kind, a
 voc. sch., with a practical 1 year program. Since becoming President
 of Mass. St. Col. in 1933, he has furthered secondary sch. ag. aggres-
 sively: by upholding Stockbridge Sch. Ag. at the College, and adding
 Wildlife Mgt.; by sustaining Ag. Teacher Training, including impor-
 tant itinerant off-the-campus features; and by supporting intimate
 and effective "Smith-Hughes" and "Smith-Lever" teamwork. Open-minded.
