 Procedure" and "Farm Economics." Among school responsibilities, em-
 phasized moral and ethical values. Highly respected by both school of-
 ficials and farmers. Active in the early deliberations of the American
 Association for the Advancement of Agricultural Teaching, 1911-; and
 an outstanding figure in national discussion of principles and plans
 of education for dirt-farmer careers, at the time when the foundations
 were being laid for education in vocational agriculture, to be sup-
 ported by State and Federal funds. A pioneer who merits remembrance.
