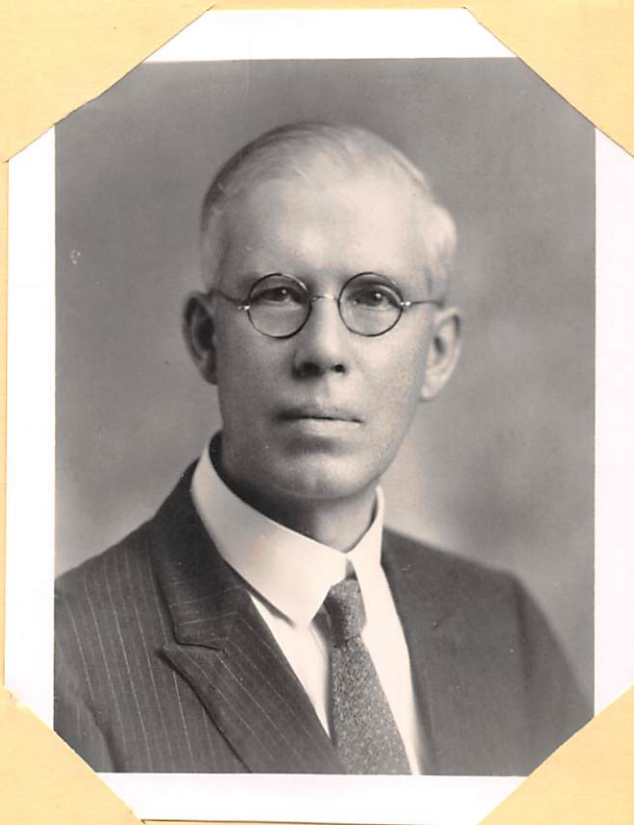


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of doctrines and methods he considered fallacious. September 12, 1944,
