

PERRIN, John L., 1896- Born and raised on a farm in Chariton County, Missouri. Graduated College of Agriculture, University of Missouri 1923, M.S., 1924, ~~in same institution~~. Additional study, University of Missouri and Ohio State University. Principal and science teacher, Marceline, Missouri 1919-21; teacher of agriculture, Milan, Missouri, 1923-27 and taught university extension courses

for rural teachers 1925-27; teacher of agriculture, Salisbury, Missouri, 1927-33 and critic teacher for University of Missouri, 1929-33; teacher of agriculture and appraiser for Federal Land Bank, Brunswick, Missouri, 1933-35; State Supervisor of Agricultural Education, Missouri, 1935-41; special representative Food Production War Training Program, U. S. Office of Education, 1941-. His insistence that practical activities be the basis of all-day, part-time and evening school instruction and the supervised farming programs be the center of all-day instruction was an important contribution to the Missouri program. — F.
