

..... SEXAUER, Theodore Edward, 1877- Iowa farm born. Began-  
 : teaching in rural schools at 16. Farmed summers, Iowa  
 : State Col.: student, half-year, 1895; grad. in Field  
 CUT : Crops, 1909; B. S. Ag. Ed., and M. S., with Rural Sociol-  
 : ogy major, 1917. Columbia Univ., M.A. in Ed., 1926.  
 : Cornell Univ., Ph.D., 1928. In Minn.: taught ag. in Albert  
 ..... Lea, 1909-1913; and there organized six cow testing associa-  
 tions, reported to have been the first in Minn. In Wis.: director  
 of ag., County School of Ag. at Menomonie, 1914-1917. In Missouri:  
 head teacher trainer in ag., Univ. Mo., 1919-1925. In Iowa: Coordina-  
tor of the Veterans Bureau in the rehabilitation of disabled soldiers,  
1918-1919, and Associate Professor of Agricultural Education, Iowa  
State College, 1928- A frequent contributor to Agricultural Education  
Magazine. Gained his farm experience, and his higher education at  
 widely spaced intervals, by thrift and foresight, perseverance and  
 sheer pluck. An outstanding pioneer in promoting school and home farm  
 cooperation in teaching vocational agriculture; and influential, in  
 person and in print, beyond the borders of his native State.
